The next order of business was the Middle Rouge Switchgear; Preventative Maintenance: The two (2) electrical feeds at the Middle Rouge Pump Station supply energy at 13,200 volts; this power is stepped down to 480 v by two (2) transformers located outside of the facilities, before being distributed to the equipment of the facility via the electrical switchgear. WTUA utilizes one of these power sources day-to-day, with second line acting as a redundant power feed. The switchgear is housed within large metal enclosures located in the Middle Rouge Electrical Room. The equipment generally consists of breakers, relays and switches. Due to the age and critical nature of the equipment, WTUA increased the frequency for preventative maintenance and inspection of the switchgear to once every two (2) years. Utilities Instrumentation Services, Inc., (UIS) of Dexter has provided this service for WTUA in the past. Because of the highly specialized skills required, local options for this work are very limited. The current fiscal year budget includes \$8,000 for inspection/maintenance of the switchgear at Middle Rouge. UIS has provided a quote for \$8,075. This is an increase of \$422 (or 5.5%) over that paid in 2014. Following discussion and upon motion by Nix supported by Price; it was

R-16-05-32 Resolved to concur with the recommendation of the Director of Operations to award a purchase order contract to Utilities Instrumentation Services, Inc., of Dexter, Michigan in an annual amount not to exceed \$8,075.00 for the preventative maintenance and inspection services at the Middle Rouge Pump Station; and

Further, that the normal bidding procedures be waived due to the limited number of service providers capable of performing this specialized work.

The next order of business was the MMRMA Insurance Policy Renewal: WTUA has been afforded insurance through the MMRMA State Pool since 1991. The current policy expires on July 1, 2016. The cost of the premium for our new policy has decreased from \$45,213 per year to \$43,363 (a decrease of \$1,860.00). This policy does not include sewage back-ups, but does include the north Pump Station property. Further, we can expect a distribution sometime this Fall.
